ATHLETIC RULES AND NOTES:

1. Competitors (except Novice) will wear the Kilt at all times while on the athletic field. Exceptions to this rule must have the prior approval of the Athletic Director and/or the Head Judge.
2. Competitors 16/17 years of age must have parent/guardian signature on this registration and parent/guardian must be present during competition.
3. All events will be governed by the Scottish American Athletic Association (SAAA) rules. The SAAA and the sponsors of the Games reserve the right to test any competitor for the use of performance altering substances.
4. Pre-registered athletes' names will be placed on a list that will be available at both gates.
5. Decisions of the Judges and Athletic Director are final.
6. The organizers of the Highland Game and the SAAA reserve the right to change, combine, or eliminate scheduled events.
7. By my signature on the entry form I release my rights to any photographs or facsimiles taken of me during my participation in the Heavy Events Competition at these games and grant the SAAA and the organizers of the Games the right to use, reproduce and publish the photographs or facsimiles at their discretion.
8. The competition is expected to include nine events of Scottish Highland athletics; however, the scheduling of final competition events is at the discretion of the Athletic Director and Judges.
