Game Shirts Guaranteed For Pre-Registered Athletes Only.

Deadline for Pre-Registration: March 20, 2010

Entries postmarked after March 20, 2010 will not be accepted for early entry. Late and field entries will be accepted on a space available basis.

Classes to be fielded are: Men's A, B, C; Men's Light<200; Women's; Novice: Masters 40+ & 50+ depending on registrations.

Athletic Rules and Notes:

1. Competitors (except Novice) will wear the Kilt at all times during the competition. Exceptions to this rule must have the prior approval of the Athletic Director and or the Head Judge.
2. Competitors 16/17 years of age must have parent/guardian signature on this registration and parent /guardian must be present during competition.
3. All events will be governed by the Scottish American Athletic Association (SAAA) rules. The SAAA and the sponsors of the games reserve the right to test any competitor for the use of performance altering substances.
4. Decisions of the Judges and Athletic Director are final.
5. The organizer of the Highland Game and the SAAA reserve the right to change, combine, or eliminate scheduled events.
6. By my signature on the entry form I release my right to any photographs or facsimiles taken of me during my participation in the Heavy Events Competition at these games and grant the SAAA and the organizers of the games the right to use, reproduce and publish the photographs or facsimiles at their discretion.
7. The competition is expected to include at least seven traditional heavy events of Scottish Highland athletics; however the scheduling of final competition events is at the discretions of the Athletic Director and Judges.
